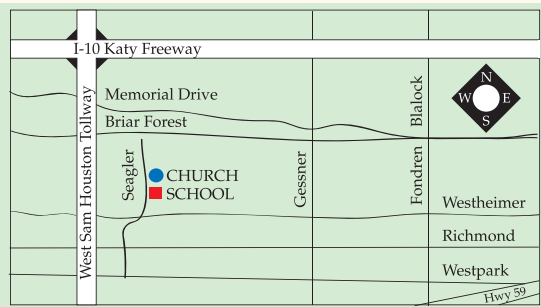


ACCREDITATION, KEY MEMBERSHIPS

EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

Safe child care for young children in a secure Christian environment

Classes—for ages 10 to 18 months, 19 to 27 months and 28 to 36 months—are staffed by qualified, caring professionals. Chapel, music and motor skills are offered once a week to children in the 28–36 months program.

Rooms house a variety of age-appropriate toys and activities, and spacious toddler playgrounds that enhance



physical development. Social interaction, self-help skills and a sense of independence are fostered. The low student-to-teacher ratio allows individual attention to be focused on each child's specific needs.

Programs operate Monday through Friday between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm. Minimum requirement: two days per week, five hours per day.
